

Timeline for Science Communication

First Grade

November – Parents/guardians receive a letter explaining the communication process, Timeline for Science Communication and Framework for Feedback about Student Performance.

February – Parents/guardians receive a brief written explanation in the report card about student progress related to the criteria from Framework for Feedback about Student Performance.

May – Parents/guardians receive student notebook with an explanation that explains how to review the notebook in relation to the criteria from Framework for Feedback about Student Performance. The notebook form will be signed and returned with student notebook.

Second Grade

November – Parents/guardians receive a letter explaining the communication process, Timeline for Science Communication and Framework for Feedback about Student Performance.

February - Parents/guardians receive a brief written explanation about student progress related to the criteria from Framework for Feedback about Student Performance and copy of the two student goals.

May – Parents/guardians receive student notebook with an explanation on how to review the notebook in relationship to the criteria from Framework for Feedback about Student Performance. The notebook form will be signed and returned with student notebook.

Third Grade

November – Parents/guardians receive a letter explaining the communication process, Timeline for Science Communication and Framework for Feedback about Student Performance.

February – Based on performance in class, with the help of the science teacher, students create two goals. Parents receive a copy of the two goals. Parents/guardians receive student notebook with an explanation on how to review the notebook in relationship to the criteria from Framework for Feedback about Student Performance. The notebook form will be signed and returned with student notebook.

May – Parents receive a report card explanation about student progress related to student goals and the criteria in “Framework.” Parents receive a portfolio containing student’s notebooks representing each year the student participated in science at Brookside. A notebook form will be signed and returned with student portfolio. (All science notebooks will be given to the student in June to take home.)
